

## Job Summary

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### Lighting Technician

**Responsible to:** Head of Lighting

**Salary:** £25,384 per annum plus overtime

**Terms:** The salary is inclusive of hours worked between 9am – 11pm daily up to 43 hours per week, spread over 6 days. Hours outside of these parameters including Sundays and Bank holidays will be paid at the appropriate overtime rate.

## **Job Description**

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### **Lighting Technician**

**Responsible to:** Head of Lighting and Deputy Head of Lighting

**Responsible for:** Casual lighting operators and technicians

**Key Objective:** To work as part of the Production Department in the delivery of lighting aspects of Young Vic Productions and related projects to the highest possible standards.

#### **Departmental responsibilities:**

- To actively contribute to the effective operation of the Production Department's work.
- To work with other staff to ensure compliance with all Health and Safety procedures and statutory regulations.
- To take an active role in the maintenance of the theatre's technical equipment.
- To participate in department administrative and HR systems as required.
- To ensure the Young Vic provides an anti-racist environment for all staff and visiting companies through inclusive production practices.

## **Production responsibilities:**

- To operate lighting & video in the Main House and other performance spaces
- To provide support to the Technical Department during fit ups and get outs.
- To work with creative teams and the technical staff to realise lighting and sound designs.
- To programme lighting desks in all spaces.
- To keep up to date with current lighting technology.
- In liaison with the Technical Director and Head of Lighting, to provide technical support for the work of other departments, including the TP (Taking Part) DP (Directors Program) and Development Departments.

## **General:**

- To carry out lamp rounds and general maintenance, including keeping track of lamp stock in the theatres and front of house.
- To uphold and embody the Young Vic's company policies, including but not limited to our Equality, Diversity and Inclusion policy, Dignity at Work policy and Health and Safety policy.
- To actively participate in and support the work experience programme of the Young Vic.
- To be an active and supportive member of the Young Vic staff team.
